Chiltern Chase

From	M40	Approx Distance	6 Miles	Approximate Time	20 Minutes
------	-----	-----------------	---------	------------------	------------

1) Exit M40 Junction 6
2) Head towards Watlington on the B4009 (+/- 2 Miles)
3) Carry on Straight into Watlington until you reach T Junction
4) Turn right heading towards Benson. Stay on this road
5) Drive through Village of Britwell Salome (+/- 1 Mile)
6) Continue on B4009 (1.5 Miles)
7) Road makes a sharp right hand drive past 1 st junction on LHS signposted Ewelme(0.2 Miles). Take next left to Ewelme (+/- 1/2 mile)
8) Follow this road into Ewelme. At junction go straight across over small bridge and bear left up through RAF Benson. (+/- 1 mile)
9) Road bends to left, follow up the hill and take the next left signposted Ewelme (+/= 1 mile)
10) Take quick left again and follow road down and up dip until car park on RHS (+/- 1mile)
11) PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY ALONG THIS ROAD – VERY NARROW

1) Exit M4 Junction 8/9
2) At roundabout take A404 (M) (Signposted Maidenhead/Henley)
3) Continue straight ahead for 1.2 miles
4) Exit slip road signed Henley
5) Turn left onto A4130 Henley Road
6) At roundabout take second exit A4130 to Henley, follow for approx 10 miles
7) Drop into Henley down Remenham Hill
8) Go over bridge into Henley
9) At traffic lights in the centre of town go right
10) At double roundabouts go straight on (A4130 signed Nettlebed/Wallingford)
11) Approx 2 miles after Nettlebed, the road widens and you drop down with a right hand bend, just after this look out for a group of houses and turn right to RAF Benson and Ewelme
12) Follow road for 1.2 miles
13) Turn right to Ewelme
14) Immediately turn left to Ewelme
15) Car park 1 mile on RHS – PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY – NARROW ROAD

There is no public transport to Ewelme.

The nearest station is Cholsey, Oxfordshire. You will need a taxi to Ewelme, which you will have to pre order.

Car Parking & Info for the Chiltern Chase

Simply enter village and follow signs.

Please try and get to the race an hour before the start. You must be parked in good time. For safety reasons you will not be allowed into the car park 10 minutes from the start. Then please lock your car and walk out of the car park via the gate you entered and turn right down onto a public footpath and through kissing gate onto a meadow. The race field (Cow Common) is in front of you. A marshal will guide you to the start.

- There will be refreshments available on Cow Common from 9am and toilet facilities open. However, there is no shelter from rain or sun. For anyone bringing family or friends supporters refreshments, hopefully with tables and chairs, will be available and the common has ample room to roam in a lovely setting.
- There will be a tent to leave bags, etc at your own risk. There are no changing facilities available.
- Any problems on the day please come to the Help Desk which will be open from 9am

Please do not park in the village, use only the allocated car park, there will be plenty of space and there are marshals who will assist with parking.
